JANUARY SPEAKER



Presentation: Native and Naturalized Orchids of Florida

Roger Hammer is a professional naturalist and survivalist instructor for the Discovery Channel's reality television show, "Naked and Afraid". He was the manager of the 120-acre **Castellow Hammock Nature Center for the** Miami-Dade County Parks Department. He received the first Marjory Stoneman Douglas Award presented by the Florida Native Plant Society in 1982, and Tropical Audubon Society honored him with the prestigious Charles Brookfield Medal in 1996. In 2003, he received the Green Palmetto Award in Education from the Florida Native Plant Society. He has given keynote speeches at Florida Native Plant Society state conferences and the 2008 World Orchid Conference in Miami. In 2012, he received an honorary Doctor of Science degree from Florida **International University and a lifetime** achievement award from the Florida Native Plant Society, Tropical Audubon Society, and the North American Butterfly Association.

It's an honor that he first met his future wife at an EALOC meeting. He currently lives with his wife, Michelle, in Homestead, Florida.
