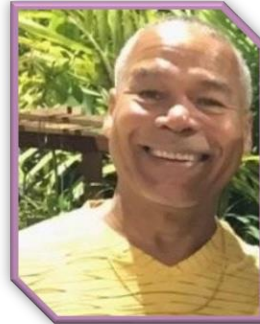

Due to the April field trip and May picnic, no speakers were booked. The June speaker will be announced at a later date.

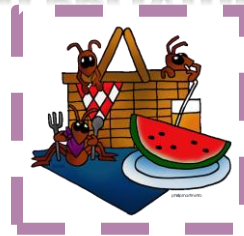
AUGUST SPEAKER

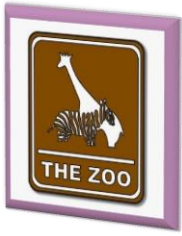
We have NO APRIL MEETING for you to sign up due to our outing to Fairchild Tropical Garden, The deadline to sign up is April 28.

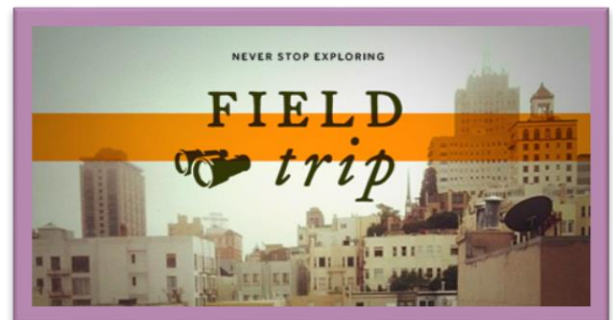
