ZOO NEWS

Maybe, the biggest Zoo News is that at the end of January, we received a confiscation. The Zoo received them and unpacked them for us. They are all bare root. They came in from the Far East. There are cattleyas and cattleya crosses. Many are lueddemannianas. Nearly all are blooming size, approximately

60 plants in all. At least half are in spike and there are about 10 seedlings.

We have had scheduling problems getting a group of volunteers out, but we are trying for Thursday, February 7, so we can get some of these plants up.

The oncidiums are starting to burst out in flower. If you go to the Zoo, look up in front of Flamingo Lake. There's a Blc. in bloom. It's a deep yellow with a deep red lip and has 11 flowers (and no thrips)! A Zoo employee was driving by and stopped to say, "Oh WOW, I'm going to get my camera out." When asked, I told him I didn't know the name. He said, "I'm going to call it scrambled eggs and ketchup."
